Thank you to all parishioners who helped us sell out Ukrainian Night.

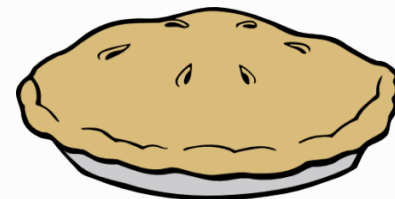
We are still accepting donations for our silent auction. These can be dropped off at the parish office.
