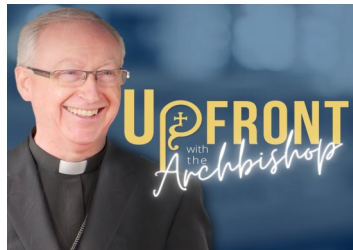
DO YOU WANT TO BECOME CATHOLIC? RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)
