PASTORAL CARE VISITS AT THE HOSPITAL

Due to changes regarding patient privacy within Alberta Health Services (AHS), if you or someone you know is admitted to the hospital, please inform the admitting staff that you are of the Catholic faith and consent to a visit from a Catholic Chaplain. It is essential that you state your Catholic religion and that you give consent for a visit from the Catholic Chaplain. You will not be able to receive a visit unless consent is given and noted on your file. If you have an upcoming surgery/procedure, you can ask your parish priest for the Sacrament of the Sick before being admitted to the hospital.

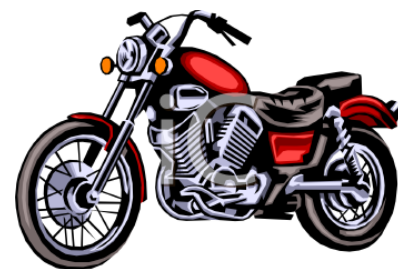
CALLING ALL SEAMSTRESSES
